HCR 52	FOIL	SEIZURES/SALES Directs the Louisiana State Law Institute to study exemptions from seizure of certain retirement accounts
SB 91	CLAITOR	CIVIL PROCEDURE Authorizes exemplary damages in civil actions for death from hazing.
SB 147	MORRELL	CRIMINAL JUSTICE Provides relative to a defamation claim brought by an alleged perpetrator of sexual misconduct against the alleged victim.
SB 164	MORRELL (TBA)	TAX/AD VALOREM Constitutional amendment to authorize the phase-in of increases in ad valorem taxation under certain circumstances. (Subject to Rule Suspension)
SB 233	MORRELL	CRIMINAL JUSTICE Nullifies nondisclosure agreements to conceal criminal activity.
SB 243	MORRELL (TBA)	CRIMINAL PROCEDURE Constitutional amendment to require unanimous juries for felonies. (Subject to Rule Suspension)
SB 288	PERRY	CHILDREN Provides relative to child support orders.
SB 358	LUNEAU	NOTARIES Authorizes and provides relative to certain electronic notarial acts.
SB 396	SMITH, G.	CHILDREN Provides relative to gestational carrier contracts.
SB 466	PRICE	LEASES Provides relative to security deposits for residential leases.
SB 497	CORTEZ	EXPROPRIATION Authorizes the expropriation of property including rights-of-way for use in certain projects in the city of Lafayette and parish of Lafayette.
SB 543	LAMBERT	SUCCESSIONS Provides relative to court costs for small successions.
