_____	<b>HB 136</b>	<b>FOIL</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Increases penalties for the manufacture, production, distribution, or possession with intent to distribute heroin
_____	<b>HB 140</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>PROBATION</b> Provides for the use of supervision fees paid by offenders placed on probation or parole
_____	<b>HB 184</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides relative to costs assessed for violations of driving while intoxicated
_____	<b>HB 186</b>	<b>MARINO</b>	<b>DRUGS/CONTROLLED</b> Provides relative to the attempt or conspiracy to commit violations of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law
_____	<b>HB 224</b>	<b>MARINO</b>	<b>DRUGS</b> Reduces criminal penalties for certain offenses involving legend drugs
_____	<b>HB 259</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>BAIL</b> Provides for presumptive pretrial release of a defendant on an unsecured personal surety or bail without surety except under certain circumstances
_____	<b>HB 260</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>CRIME/DNA</b> Provides relative to DNA collection for certain offenses
_____	<b>HB 266</b>	<b>THIBAUT</b>	<b>GAMING/REVENUE</b> Provides with respect to the distribution of monies from the Video Draw Poker Purse Supplement Fund
_____	<b>HB 283</b>	<b>PYLANT</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Prohibits the intentional damaging or tampering of a tracking device on certain motor vehicles

_____	<b>HB 301</b>	<b>BROWN, CHAD</b>	<b>GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER</b> Provides relative to the definition of "video draw poker device" and "video draw poker"
_____	<b>HB 318</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides relative to prior convictions of the crime of operating a vehicle while intoxicated
_____	<b>HB 464</b>	<b>BISHOP, S.</b>	<b>GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER</b> Amends regulations on restaurants, parking lots, and fuel sales at qualified truck stop facilities and requirements for video poker games on video draw poker devices
_____	<b>HB 525</b>	<b>BAGNERIS</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides relative to the crime of operating a vehicle while intoxicated
_____	<b>HB 537</b>	<b>MARINO</b>	<b>PROBATION</b> Provides relative to probation for fourth noncapital felony offenses under certain circumstances
_____	<b>HB 581</b>	<b>LEGER</b>	<b>GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER</b> Provides relative to fuel sales at qualified truck stop facilities
_____	<b>HB 592</b>	<b>TALBOT</b>	<b>GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER</b> Provides relative to the regulations for and authority of owners or lessors of a qualified truck stop facility
_____	<b>HB 594</b>	<b>CARTER, G.</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime which would prohibit telemarketing targeted at the elderly population
_____	<b>HB 622</b>	<b>MAGEE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to the payment of fines, fees, costs, restitution, and other monetary obligations related to an offender's conviction
_____	<b>HB 661</b>	<b>JAMES</b>	<b>DRUGS</b> Provides relative to drug paraphernalia
_____	<b>HB 699</b>	<b>STAGNI</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/JURY TRIALS</b> Removes the requirement that a juror provide a name and signature for jury polling purposes
