_____	<b>HB 717</b>	<b>IVEY</b>	<b>MUSEUMS</b> Provides for the membership of certain museum boards
_____	<b>HB 718</b>	<b>CONNICK</b>	<b>ETHICS/CODE</b> Prohibits former agency heads in the executive branch of state government from assisting persons, for compensation, with their former departments or any agency therein for a period of three years after public service
_____	<b>SB 174</b>	<b>PERRY</b>	<b>PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS</b> Provides relative to the Old Arsenal Museum. (gov sig)
