_____	<b>HB 114</b>	<b>PUGH</b>	<b>WILDLIFE &amp; FISHERIES</b> Prohibits the capture or transport of the common musk turtle for commercial purposes
_____	<b>HB 130</b>	<b>SCHEXNAYDER</b>	<b>WILDLIFE/MGT AREAS</b> Provides for the establishment of airboat trails on wildlife management areas
_____	<b>HB 228</b>	<b>ANDERS</b>	<b>HUNTING/DEER</b> Prohibits installation or use of a deer or turkey stand or stationary hunting position within fifty yards of a property line
_____	<b>HB 411</b>	<b>SCHEXNAYDER</b>	<b>WATERWAYS/SCENIC RIVERS</b> Exempts the Tickfaw River from certain restrictions of the Natural and Scenic Rivers Program
_____	<b>HB 425</b>	<b>ZERINGUE</b>	<b>FISHING/COMMERCIAL</b> Includes charter fishing guides, for purposes of taxation, in the certification program as earning more than half of their income from charter fishing guide activities
_____	<b>HB 435</b>	<b>MORRIS, JAY</b>	<b>BOATS/SHIPS/VESSELS</b> Authorizes the regulation or prohibition of boat traffic on Lake Bartholomew in certain circumstances
_____	<b>HB 442</b>	<b>THIBAUT</b>	<b>WATERWAYS/LAKES</b> Delineates the boundary between state ownership and private ownership of the land adjacent to False River

_____	<b>HB 549</b>	<b>WHITE, MALINDA</b>	<b>BOATS/SHIPS/VESSELS</b> Registration of non-motorized house boats
_____	<b>HB 687</b>	<b>ZERINGUE</b>	<b>WILDLIFE &amp; FISHERIES</b> Restructuring of hunting and fishing licenses
_____	<b>HB 688</b>	<b>LYONS</b>	<b>ENVIRONMENT/LITTERING</b> Correct statutory references for the litter program from the Department of Environmental Quality to the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries
_____	<b>HB 706</b>	<b>ZERINGUE</b>	<b>FISHING/RECREATIONAL</b> Relative to possession limits of filleted red drum, spotted sea trout, or Southern flounder on board a vessel while on the water
_____	<b>HB 714</b>	<b>HAVARD</b>	<b>HUNTING/SEASONS</b> Sets turkey hunting season dates
_____	<b>HB 722</b>	<b>ZERINGUE</b>	<b>FISHING/OYSTERS</b> Requires oysters taken or sold to be "wholesome and marketable" and describes what qualifies as a "wholesome and marketable" oyster
