_____	<b>HR 142</b>	<b>HARRIS, L.</b>	<b>HOUSE/RULES</b> Provides for a procedure to pass over controversial instruments on third reading, to be referred to as the "Berthelot Rule"
_____	<b>SB 31</b>	<b>APPEL</b>	<b>ELECTED OFFICIALS</b> Constitutional amendment to provide for disqualification from holding an elective office. (2/3-CA13sl(A))
_____	<b>SB 142</b>	<b>PETERSON</b>	<b>SUNSET LAW</b> Re-creates the Department of State Civil Service and the statutory entities made a part of the department by law. (6/30/18)
_____	<b>SB 419</b>	<b>PETERSON</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Repeals provision for recusal for members of the Board of Commissioners of the Port of New Orleans and changes provisions permitting certain persons to serve on the board. (8/1/18)
_____	<b>SB 457</b>	<b>WALSWORTH</b>	<b>ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for recall election petitions. (gov sig)
