<b>HCR 93</b>	<b>HILFERTY</b>	<b>STATE EMPLOYEE/LEAVE</b> Requests the legislative auditor to report on the status of family and parental leave for all state employees
<b>HCR 104</b>	<b>IVEY (TBA)</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS</b> Creates a joint committee to study the information technology systems used by legislative agencies <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>SB 19</b>	<b>BOUDREAUX</b>	<b>HEALTH DEPARTMENT</b> Provides relative to criminal history record information obtained by the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners. (8/1/19)
<b>SB 182</b>	<b>HEWITT (TBA)</b>	<b>SUITS AGAINST STATE</b> Provides for the participation of a sexual harasser in a settlement or judgment in a sexual harassment claim. (gov sig) <b>(Subject to Rule Suspension)</b>
<b>SB 238</b>	<b>MIZELL</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Provides for abortion clinic employees to be mandatory reporters of

human trafficking and certain sexual based crimes to law enforcement and provides for the additional postings of the National Human Trafficking Resource Center hotline information. (8/1/19)
