_____	HCR 58	MIGUEZ	GOVERNOR Suspends certain provisions of Title 29 of the La. Revised Statutes relative to the governor's authority to declare an emergency, disaster, or public health emergency
_____	HCR 30	DWIGHT	VOTERS/VOTING Suspends certain provisions of law relative to the time by which a voter must be registered as affiliated with a particular political party to be eligible to vote for candidates for membership on that party's committees
_____	HB 798	DWIGHT	PUBLIC MEETINGS Authorizes public bodies to allow members to participate and vote electronically during certain states of emergency subject to certain conditions
_____	HB 868	IVEY	LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS Provides relative to the continuity of the legislature in times of emergency or disaster
_____	HB 497	IVEY	LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR Requires each auditee in state government to provide the legislative auditor with direct access to data
