HR 52	SCHEXNAYDER	COLLEGES/COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL Requests that the Board of Supervisors of Community and Technical Colleges and Board of Regents study and report relative to changes needed for community and technical colleges in response to COVID-19
 SCR 62	MILLIGAN	<b>SCHOOLS</b> Requests the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to implement a traumatic injury response program in all public schools.
 SCR 63	JACKSON	<b>BESE</b> Requests the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education to create a task force to develop and oversee continuous learning outside of normal practices.
 SB 318	CATHEY	<b>TOPS</b> Provides for TOPS-Tech award eligibility for certain military veterans. (gov sig)
