INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

HB 21	OWEN, CHARLES	LIABILITY/CIVIL Provides for civil liability for the intentional dissemination of personally identifiable information
HB 59	LACOMBE	DISTRICTS/WATERWORKS (Constitutional Amendment) Authorizes a political subdivision to waive water charges incurred through damage not caused by the customer
HB 196	JORDAN	CONSTITUTION/AMENDMENT (Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits slavery and involuntary servitude
HB 255	OWEN, CHARLES	CIVIL/INTERDICTION Provides relative to interdiction and curatorship
HB 449	CARTER, WILFORD	CHILDREN/SUPPORT Provides relative to the suspension of a child support obligation during the obligor's incarceration
SB 9	PRICE	CHILDREN'S CODE Provides relative to continuous revision of the Children's Code. (8/1/21)
SB 62	MILLIGAN	CIVIL COMMITMENT Provides relative to the management of the affairs of an interdict. (8/1/21)
SB 91	PEACOCK	SECURITIES Authorizes transfer on death of certain securities. (1/1/22)

OTHER BUSINESS:

Persons who do not feel comfortable giving testimony in person at this time may submit a prepared statement in accordance with House Rule 14.33 in lieu of appearing before the committee:

A. Any interested person or any committee member may file with the committee a prepared statement concerning a specific instrument or matter under consideration by the committee or concerning any matter within the committee's scope of authority, and the committee records shall reflect receipt of such statement and the date and time thereof.

B. Any person who files a prepared statement which contains data or statistical information shall include in such prepared statement sufficient information to identify the source of the data or

statistical information. For the purposes of this Paragraph, the term "source" shall mean a publication, website, person, or other source from which the data or statistical information contained in the prepared statement was obtained by the person or persons who prepared the statement.

NOTE: Statements emailed to h-clp@legis.la.gov and received prior to noon on Monday, May 10, 2021, will be distributed to the committee members prior to the meeting.
