 SB 147	MILLS, ROBERT	SELF INSURANCE Creates the Louisiana Churches and Nonprofit Religious Organizations Self-Insured Fund. (gov sig)
 SB 156	DUPLESSIS	INSURANCE POLICIES Provides that no property insurance policy shall prohibit an insured from hiring a public adjuster. (8/1/23)
 SB 171	MILLS, FRED	PHARMACEUTICALS Creates the pharmacy benefit managers quality incentive program. (gov sig)
 SCR 7	TALBOT	PROPERTY INSURANCE Urges the commissioner of insurance to create the Hurricane Mitigation Commission to study and report findings and recommendations relative to the handling of property insurance claims in the wake of hurricanes and the necessity of a catastrophe savings account.
