<b>SB 35</b>	<b>MORRIS, JAY</b>	<b>LIABILITY</b> Provides for sale of litigious rights.
<b>SB 39</b>	<b>MIZELL</b>	<b>CHILDREN'S CODE</b> Provides for continuous revisions to the Children's Code.
<b>SB 41</b>	<b>MORRIS, JAY</b>	<b>CHILDREN'S CODE</b> Provides that part of the Children's Code's purpose is to promote public safety.
<b>SB 75</b>	<b>MORRIS, JAY</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Provides for electronic filing and record retention.
<b>SB 333</b>	<b>MORRIS, JAY</b>	<b>CIVIL PROCEDURE</b> Provides for methods of enforcing mortgages.
