HB 91	BACALA	TRESPASS Provides relative to the crime of criminal trespass on running waters of the state
HB 129	BAYHAM	CRIME/THEFT Provides relative to the penalties for theft of a motor vehicle
HB 414	CARLSON	CRIME/OBSCENITY Provides relative to the applicability of the crime of obscenity pertaining to public libraries
HB 415	FONTENOT	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides relative to the refusal to accept surrender of surety
HB 578	LYONS	CORRECTIONS Creates the Back on Track Youth Pilot Program
HB 733	BAYHAM	BAIL Provides for the fixing of the amount of bail
HB 805	BRYANT	CRIME Provides a justification defense to domestic violence victim-defendants
HB 901	LANDRY, MANDIE	PARDON Provides relative to the Crime Victims Services Bureau within the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections
SB 6	CONNICK	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Creates the crime of unlawful dissemination or sale of images of another created by artificial intelligence
SB 7	CONNICK	CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES Provides for reporting of escapes from juvenile institutions
SB 33	HENSGENS	THEFT Provides relative to theft from a porch or other unenclosed portion of a residence or inhabited dwelling
SB 34	HENSGENS	THEFT Provides relative to coordinated retail robbery offenses
SB 161	BOUDREAUX	CONTRACTORS Provides for non-governmental agencies to receive background checks on contractors within the volunteer and employee criminal history system

SB 183	CARTER, GARY	JUVENILE JUSTICE Provides relative to academic plans for children committed to the Department of Public Safety and Corrections
SB 251	BARROW	CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES Provides relative to educational programs provided by correctional facilities
SB 387	KLEINPETER	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Creates the crime of vandalizing, tampering with, or destroying a crime camera system
SB 476	OWEN, ROBERT	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Criminalizes the use of bait dogs in the training process for dog fighting
