HB 640	GALLE	LIBRARIES Provides relative to members of library boards of control
HB 657	AMEDEE	CULTURE/FRENCH Provides relative to the membership, powers and duties, and reporting requirements of the Council for the Development of French in Louisiana (CODOFIL)
HB 688	LARVADAIN	LOCAL GOVERNMENT Provides relative to training requirements for local government officials
HB 691	LACOMBE	CIVIL SERVICE/FIRE & POL Provides relative to the reemployment of employees who have resigned or retired from the classified service due to injury or medical condition
HB 724	MILLER, D.	DISTRICTS/SPECIAL Provides relative to the collection of fees imposed by a stormwater management utility district located in St. Landry Parish
HB 761	LACOMBE	TAX INCREMENT FINANCING Authorizes certain municipalities to create tax increment financing districts
HB 777	DICKERSON	LIBRARIES Provides relative to the use of public funds
HB 907	BAGLEY	MUSEUMS Provides for the governance of state museums and the transfer of museums from the Department of State to the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism
HB 941	KNOX	SEWERAGE/NO WATER BD Provides relative to the New Orleans Sewerage and Water Board
HB 946	GALLE	LIBRARIES Provides relative to members of parish library boards of control

HB 955	MARCELLE	HOUSING/AUTHORITIES Provides that housing authorities are exempt from certain fees and requirements for surety
HCR 54	KERNER	INSURANCE/PROPERTY Requests the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development to confer with the Jefferson Parish Community Development Department to consider modifications to required property insurance coverage
HR 9	JOHNSON, TRAVIS	PARISHES Requests the governing authority of Concordia Parish to do a feasibility study regarding the establishment of a new form of parish government
