HCR 79	CARTER, WILFORD	CRIMINAL/SENTENCING Requests the La. State Law Institute to study and provide recommendations relative to minimum and maximum sentencing ranges
HB 56	NEWELL	ABORTION Provides relative to exceptions to abortion
HB 63	NEWELL	ABORTION Amends definitions relative to the crime of abortion
HB 164	BOYD	ABORTION Provides for exceptions to the abortion laws of this state relative to rape and incest
HB 293	FREEMAN	ABORTION Provides for the definition of abortion
HB 408	LANDRY, MANDIE	WEAPONS/FIREARMS Provides for the creation of the "Louisiana Voluntary Do Not Sell List"
HB 627	LANDRY, MANDIE	WEAPONS Provides relative to permitless concealed carry
HB 630	LANDRY, MANDIE	CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE Provides relative to criminal prosecution of certain pregnancy outcomes
SB 17	MIZELL	CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE Adds Tianeptine to Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substance Law
SB 276	PRESSLY	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Creates the crime of coerced criminal abortion by means of fraud to prohibit a third-party from knowingly using an abortion-inducing drug to cause, or attempt to cause, an abortion on an unsuspecting pregnant mother without her knowledge or consent and amends various abortion criminal laws to add the crime of attempted abortion
SB 306	CATHEY	CRIME/PUNISHMENT Increases the penalty for human trafficking involving sexual activity of persons under the age of eighteen
SB 421	LUNEAU	JUVENILE JUSTICE Creates a renaissance district in certain parishes
