**INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:**

<b>HR 133</b>	<b>OWEN, CHARLES</b>	<b>HOMELAND SECURITY</b> Requests the House Select Committee on Homeland Security to review state government actions during the COVID-19 Pandemic and postpandemic period and make recommendations to improve the government's response in future health emergencies
<b>HCR 60</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>COURTS/MAYORS</b> Requests a study of the feasibility and practicality of mayor's courts
<b>HB 54</b>	<b>NEWELL</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Provides relative to the regulation of cannabis
<b>HB 370</b>	<b>ORGERON</b>	<b>ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES</b> Allows any wine producer or manufacturer to sell sparkling and still wine on or off premises and ship directly to a consumer
<b>HB 380</b>	<b>ZERINGUE</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Provides relative to electronic filings
<b>HB 533</b>	<b>WRIGHT</b>	<b>JUDGES/SUPREME COURT</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for the appointment of justices of the supreme court
<b>HB 831</b>	<b>EGAN</b>	<b>JUDGES</b> Provides relative to mandatory judicial training
<b>HB 915</b>	<b>WYBLE</b>	<b>AIRCRAFT/AVIATION</b> Prohibits the procurement of certain unmanned aircraft systems
<b>HB 951</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>POLICE/STATE</b> Provides for collection and reporting of data
<b>SCR 5</b>	<b>FESI</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Requests state and local law enforcement agencies to cooperate with federal authorities in discovering and closing clandestine branches of the Chinese Ministry of Public Security.
<b>SB 78</b>	<b>MORRIS, JAY</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature, by law, to establish additional courts enacted by a two-thirds vote. (2/3 - CA12s1(A))
<b>SB 159</b>	<b>CATHEY</b>	<b>VETERANS</b> Creates the Preserving Lawful Utilization of Services for Veterans Act. (gov sig)

<b>SB 177</b>	<b>MORRIS, JAY</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Constitutional amendment to increase the non-lawyer membership of and provide for the selection judiciary commission members and to require investigations be conducted by directive of the supreme court. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
<b>SB 208</b>	<b>MIGUEZ</b>	<b>INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS</b> Provides for sanctuary policies. (gov sig)
<b>SB 223</b>	<b>OWEN, ROBERT</b>	<b>ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES</b> Provides for the definition of "solicitor" with respect to alcohol. (8/1/24)
<b>SB 227</b>	<b>HODGES</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Provides for training requirements for part-time and reserve peace officers. (gov sig)
<b>SB 402</b>	<b>DUPLESSIS</b>	<b>CRIMINAL PROCEDURE</b> Provides that victims be allowed to directly address a defendant when providing a victim impact statement. (8/1/24)
<b>SB 439</b>	<b>MIZELL</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Requires in-person trauma-informed training for law enforcement officers. (8/1/24)
<b>SB 447</b>	<b>MIZELL</b>	<b>HEALTH DEPARTMENT</b> Provides relative to coroners. (gov sig)
<b>SB 452</b>	<b>MCMATH</b>	<b>CORONERS</b> Provides relative to the coroner of St. Tammany Parish. (gov sig)
