HB 769	RISER	WORKERS COMPENSATION Creates a civil liability for denial of medical expenses
SB 293	EDMONDS	<b>WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT</b> Provides primary point of contact for workforce solutions. (8/1/24)
SB 356	JACKSON-ANDREWS	<b>WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT</b> Provides for workforce training and education initiative for public assistance recipients. (8/1/24)
SCR 11	REESE	<b>CONGRESS</b> Urges the Congress of the United States to amend federal law to allow states to provide for the consolidation of federally funded workforce development services with federally funded social safety net services.
