INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

<b>HR 61</b>	<b>WRIGHT</b>	<b>TAX/STATE</b> Authorizes the House Committee on Ways and Means, or a subcommittee thereof, to study the state's tax structure and develop recommendations for tax system reforms
<b>HR 119</b>	<b>JOHNSON, MIKE</b>	<b>AGRICULTURE</b> Authorizes and requests the chairman of the House Committee on Agriculture, Forestry, Aquaculture and Rural Development to appoint a subcommittee to study and address the devastation of the forest industry due to the infestation of beetles
<b>HCR 64</b>	<b>ORGERON</b>	<b>ENERGY/ALTERNATE</b> Creates the Clean Hydrogen Task Force
<b>HB 111</b>	<b>BAYHAM</b>	<b>GOVERNOR</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for gubernatorial term limits
<b>SCR 2</b>	<b>ABRAHAM</b>	<b>CONGRESS</b> Memorializes Congress to call for a convention of states to amend the United States Constitution to establish a limitation on terms for the members of congress.
<b>SB 30</b>	<b>MILLER, G.</b>	<b>ETHICS</b> Provides relative to annual financial disclosure statements by certain elected officials and public servants. (8/1/24)
<b>SB 52</b>	<b>MILLER, G.</b>	<b>CAMPAIGN FINANCE</b> Provides relative to filing financial disclosure statements after qualifying for office. (8/1/24)
<b>SB 140</b>	<b>BASS</b>	<b>REVENUE SECRETARY</b> Provides relative to objections to candidacy. (gov sig)
<b>SB 248</b>	<b>WOMACK</b>	<b>LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR</b> Requires the legislative auditor to audit certain capital outlay procedures. (gov sig)

<b>HB 28</b>	<b>MELERINE</b>	<b>JUDGES/SUPREME COURT</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Increases the number of associate supreme court justices
<b>HB 116</b>	<b>MCKIN</b>	<b>PUBLIC RECORDS</b> Provides relative to the disclosure of personnel records of public employees
<b>HB 176</b>	<b>MELERINE</b>	<b>REAPPORTIONMENT/JUDGES</b> Provides for nine election districts for the election of the justices of the supreme court
<b>HB 771</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>REAPPORTIONMENT/HOUSE</b> Provides for the districts for the election of members of the House of Representatives
<b>HB 912</b>	<b>JORDAN</b>	<b>REAPPORTIONMENT/SENATE</b> Provides for redistricting the Louisiana Senate
<b>SB 68</b>	<b>PRESSLY</b>	<b>JUDGES</b> Provides for appointment of an ad hoc judge for election contests and challenges. (8/1/24)
<b>SB 96</b>	<b>JENKINS</b>	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Provides relative to voter registration. (gov sig)
<b>SB 155</b>	<b>KLEINPETER</b>	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Provides relative to marking absentee by mail ballots. (8/1/24)
<b>SB 198</b>	<b>KLEINPETER</b>	<b>ELECTION CODE</b> Provides relative to prohibitions to dual candidacy. (8/1/24)
<b>SB 218</b>	<b>KLEINPETER</b>	<b>VOTERS/VOTING</b> Provides relative to voting. (8/1/24)
<b>SB 388</b>	<b>HODGES</b>	<b>CRIME/PUNISHMENT</b> Creates the crime of unlawful entry or reentry into the state of Louisiana by an alien. (See Act)
