INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

HB 206	MELERINE	ELECTIONS Requires legislative authorization to give effect to certain actions regarding election procedures inconsistent with the Election Code
HB 216	JACKSON	ETHICS/BOARD Provides for the broadcast and recordation of meetings of the Board of Ethics
HB 342	BAYHAM	ELECTIONS/CANDIDATES Provides relative to qualifying fees and nominating petitions for certain candidates
HB 385	BRYANT	PUBLIC OFFICIALS Provides that the oath or affirmation of a public official shall be recorded at no charge to the official
HB 397	BEAULLIEU	ETHICS/CODE Provides for revisions to the Code of Governmental Ethics
HB 502	BUTLER	REGISTRARS OF VOTERS Provides for the compensation, evaluation, duties, and removal of registrars of voters
HB 590	SPELL, ANNIE	ELECTIONS Provides relative to foreign funding for elections and ballot measures
HB 603	MCKIN	BOARDS/COMMISSIONS Amends the appointing process for certain occupational licensing boards, committees, and authorities
HB 617	CARVER	CHILDREN/DCFS Reorganizes the Department of Children and Family Services
HB 624	BERAULT	WORKFORCE COMMISSION Transfers certain family and support programs from the Department of Children and Family Services to the Louisiana Workforce Commission and renames Louisiana Workforce Commission to Louisiana Works
HB 625	BUTLER	ELECTIONS/SPECIAL Provides for a special statewide election on April 18, 2026, for submitting proposed constitutional amendments to the state's electors

Any interested person or any committee member may file with the committee a prepared statement concerning a specific instrument or matter under consideration by the committee or concerning any matter within the committee's scope of authority, and the committee records shall reflect receipt of such statement and the date and time thereof.
