INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

HB 119	DESHOTEL	<b>MOTOR VEHICLES</b> Decreases the minimum light transmission percentage allowable for the front side window tint of motor vehicles
HB 170	COX	<b>MTR VEHICLE/COMMERCIAL</b> Removes the requirement that taxi cab drivers obtain a chauffeur's license
HB 221	BAGLEY	<b>MTR VEHICLE/INSPECTION</b> Provides relative to a motor vehicle inspection tax
HB 232	BAGLEY	<b>MTR VEHICLE/INSPECTION</b> Eliminates the state inspection sticker requirement for certain vehicles
HB 301	DOMANGUE	<b>WATERWAYS/OBSTRUCTIONS</b> Provides for the removal and salvage of abandoned vessels in waterways
HB 474	BRAUD	<b>MTR VEHICLE/EMERGENCY</b> Provides relative to emergency vehicles for coroners
HB 476	FONTENOT	<b>MTR VEHICLE/DEALERS</b> Provides relative to an annual automatic adjustment to a fee for motor vehicle dealers based on the Consumer Price Index
HB 499	BAMBURG	<b>TRAFFIC/VIOLATIONS</b> Establishes penalties for persons exceeding the speed limit or breaching construction zones and utility work safety zones under active construction with workers on site
HB 519	GLORIOSO	<b>MTR VEHICLE/VIOLATIONS</b> Provides relative to the operation of a motor vehicle while using a wireless telecommunication device
HB 554	MCKIN	<b>MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC</b> Establishes a notice of voting restriction and a restriction code applicable to persons who are not United States citizens and aliens lawfully present in the United States but have not attained United States citizenship
HB 580	ILLG	<b>PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECTIONS</b> Increase the penalties for operating a vehicle with fictitious plates and provides for specifications for temporary registration plates issued by dealers and the display of temporary registrations plates issued by dealers

<b>HB 630</b>	<b>BAYHAM</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC</b> Reduces the fee applicable to updating a driver's license to comply with REAL ID standards
<b>HB 631</b>	<b>BAYHAM</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC</b> Reduces the fee applicable to updating a name on a driver's license
