HB 197	JOHNSON, MIKE	MALPRACTICE/MEDICAL Expands application of medical malpractice to include physical therapist assistants and occupational therapist assistants

HB 295	TARVER, PHILLIP	APPROPRIATIONS (Constitutional Amendment) Limits the amount of State General Fund (Direct) revenues that may be appropriated in a fiscal year for recurring expenses and restricts use of such revenues above that limit
HB 343	DAVIS	SEIZURES/SALES Provides relative to condominium associations
HB 575	VENTRELLA	ABORTION Provides relative to liability for the unlawful termination of a pregnancy
SB 35	PRICE	SERVITUDES Provides for legal servitudes
SB 49	MILLER, G.	WILLS/TESTAMENTS Provides for validity of testaments
SB 67	FOIL	SUCCESSIONS Provides for the continuous revision of successions
SB 93	LAMBERT	SUCCESSIONS Provides for enforceability of penalty clauses in wills
SB 116	KLEINPETER	NOTARIES Provides for reciprocal notarial authority of notaries qualified in St. Martin Parish and St. Landry Parish
