INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

HR 3	ECHOLS	SCHOOLS/FOOD PROGRAMS Requests the state Department of Education to study the feasibility of and potential costs associated with prohibiting certain foods and beverages in public schools
HR 4	ECHOLS	SCHOOLS/FOOD PROGRAMS Memorializes the United States Congress to support funding for the ability to focus on purchasing American agricultural products and the removal of ultra-processed food and beverages from K-12 public schools
HCR 37	HUGHES	HIGHER EDUCATION Establishes the Hazing Prevention Task Force
HB 243	LANDRY, MANDIE	STUDENT/ASSESSMENT Provides relative to student assessment and school accountability with respect to the Louisiana Giving All True Opportunity to Rise (LA GATOR) Scholarship Program
HB 279	BOYD	HIGHER EDUCATION Requires certain postsecondary education students to complete an anti-hazing course
HB 391	STAGNI	TEACHERS/EVALUATION Amends the student growth component in the evaluation of teachers and administrators
SB 117	MIGUEZ	NUTRITION Prohibits the serving and selling of ultra-processed foods in public schools. (gov sig)
SB 160	CATHEY	SCHOOLS Allows transportation network companies to transport students to and from school and school related functions. (gov sig)
