HB 164	BILLINGS	WILDLIFE & FISHERIES Provides relative to mallard hunting licenses for hunting preserves
HB 165	EDMONSTON	WATERWAYS Removes the designated deadline the board of the Amite River Basin Drainage and Water Conservation District has to promulgate regulations for watershed management within the district
HB 172	EDMONSTON	WATERWAYS Extends the period for which the Comite River is exempt from certain provisions of the Louisiana Scenic Rivers Act
HB 286	HENRY, CHANCE	ENVIRONMENT/ENFORCEMENT Provides for the maximum civil penalty for citations issued through the expedited enforcement program
HB 353	MACK	ENERGY Provides relative to carbon dioxide sequestration
HB 497	LACOMBE	FISHING Provides for the Louisiana Catch and Cook Program
HB 568	CARRIER	ENERGY/CONSERVATION Establishes public safety and accountability procedures applicable to carbon capture and storage projects
HB 583	LANDRY, JACOB	ENERGY Establishes state policy regarding affordable, reliable energy and grid resilience
HB 585	MCCORMICK	ENERGY Requires advance notice to surface and mineral owners prior to permitting or performing carbon dioxide sequestration activities
HB 602	LANDRY, JACOB	MINERALS Provides relative to remediation of oilfield and exploration and production sites
HB 605	RISER	NATURAL RESOURCES DEPT Authorizes a fee for expedited processing performed by the Department of Energy and Natural Resources
HB 608	COATES	ENVIRONMENT Creates the Louisiana Atmospheric Protection Act
HB 632	RISER	ENERGY Protects mineral servitude ownership in relation to carbon dioxide sequestration

HB 634	LANDRY, JACOB	MINERALS To provide relative to remediation of oilfield sites
HCR 8	BAYHAM	SEAFOOD Memorializes Congress to compel the United States Food and Drug Administration to increase inspection and testing of imported seafood
HCR 27	ZERINGUE	COASTAL RES/COASTAL ZONE Urges and requests enhancement of the state's participation in the Gulf of America Hypoxia Action Plan and Task Force
