INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

HB 307	HENRY, CHANCE	<b>PUBLIC ASSISTANCE</b> Requires individuals requesting public assistance who are not United States citizens be reported to United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement
HB 346	DESHOTEL	<b>FUNDS/FUNDING</b> To establish the Local Infrastructure Fund
HB 348	NEWELL	<b>SUPPLEMENTAL PAY</b> Provides supplemental pay for fire protection officers for the Lakefront Management Authority
HB 349	NEWELL	<b>CIVIL SERVICE/STATE</b> (Constitutional Amendment) Provides for supplemental pay for fire protection officers employed by an airport authority.
HB 357	FREEMAN	<b>INSURANCE/HEALTH</b> Requires health insurance coverage for integrative cancer treatments
HB 378	WILDER	<b>TOPS</b> Lowers the ACT score required for initial qualification for a Taylor Opportunity Program for Students award for students who complete approved home study programs
HB 467	HILFERTY	<b>INSURANCE/HEALTH</b> Requires health insurance coverage for amino acid-based elemental formulas
HB 502	BUTLER	<b>REGISTRARS OF VOTERS</b> Provides for the compensation, evaluation, duties, and removal of registrars of voters
HB 533	CARVER	<b>TAX CREDITS</b> Establishes the Work-Based Learning Tax Credit for employment of apprentices, interns, and youth workers
HB 622	HILFERTY	<b>INSURANCE/HEALTH</b> Requires health insurance coverage for histotripsy procedures
HB 624	BERAULT	<b>WORKFORCE COMMISSION</b> Transfers certain family and support programs from the Department of Children and Family Services to the Louisiana Workforce Commission and renames Louisiana Workforce Commission to Louisiana Works

<b>HB 648</b>	<b>BEAULLIEU</b>	<b>ELECTIONS/CANDIDATES</b> Increases candidate qualifying fees and dedicates the monies to the Campaign Sign Recycling Fund
<b>HB 663</b>	<b>FIRMENT</b>	<b>TAX/INSURANCE PREMIUM</b> Provides for the disposition of certain state sales and use tax collections for the purpose of fortifying residential roofs in the coastal zone
<b>HB 673</b>	<b>MUSCARELLO</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Repeals provisions relative to compensation for wrongful conviction and imprisonment
<b>HB 675</b>	<b>GLORIOSO</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to post conviction relief
