HB 62	TARVER, PHILLIP	LOCAL GOVERNMENT Authorizes parish governing authorities to create commercial property assessed capital expenditure and resilience programs
HB 108	DOMANGUE	MUSEUMS/STATE MUSEUM Provides relative to the position of museum director for the Louisiana State Museum

HB 299	THOMPSON	CEMETERIES Increases the maximum rate of ad valorem taxes the governing authority of Morehouse Parish is authorized to levy for public cemeteries and provides for the use of the proceeds of the taxes
HB 319	ORGERON	BOARDS/COMMISSIONS Provides relative to the Atchafalaya Trace Commission and Atchafalaya Trace Heritage Area
HB 410	KNOX	LOCAL GOVERNMENT Provides relative to renovations of certain property in historic preservation districts
HB 609	LANDRY, MANDIE	SEWERAGE/NO WATER BD Provides relative to the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans
SB 29	HENSGENS	SPECIAL DISTRICTS Repeals provisions of the Vermilion Economic Development District. (gov sig)
SB 43	MCMATH	TAX/LOCAL Provides for occupancy taxes levied by the governing authority for St. Tammany Parish. (8/1/25)

SB 54	MIZELL	LOCAL AGENCIES Provides for a limited fiscal administrator for political subdivisions. (8/1/25)
SB 63	JENKINS	PRIVILEGES/LIENS Provides for a privilege by municipalities against multifamily residential properties for unpaid sewage disposal and water system service charges or user fees. (8/1/25)
SB 210	CLOUD	MUSEUMS Provides relative to state museums. (8/1/25)
