INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

<b>HB 461</b>	<b>LANDRY, MANDIE</b>	<b>BUILDING CODES</b> Provides relative to allowing municipalities or parishes to adopt certain construction standards
<b>HB 467</b>	<b>FREEMAN</b>	<b>BUILDING CODES</b> Provides relative to standards when constructing a residential roof in a parish in the coastal zone boundary
<b>HB 522</b>	<b>FONTENOT</b>	<b>FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL</b> Provides relative to authority of the state fire marshal to make arrests and carry firearms
<b>HB 565</b>	<b>MCKAMIN</b>	<b>CHILDREN/CARE</b> Provides relative to fire safety provisions for day care centers
<b>HB 673</b>	<b>PHELPS</b>	<b>PROPERTY/ABANDONED</b> Authorizes the state fire marshal to require owners of abandoned or blighted structures to install and maintain security cameras on property
<b>HB 799</b>	<b>FONTENOT</b>	<b>FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL</b> Provides relative to boilers
<b>HB 917</b>	<b>DESHOTEL</b>	<b>FIRE PROTECTION</b> Provides relative to life safety and property protection licensing
<b>HB 937</b>	<b>LACOMBE</b>	<b>AMUSEMENT PARKS</b> Provides relative to revisions of the Amusement Rides Safety Law
<b>HB 956</b>	<b>FONTENOT</b>	<b>FIRE PROTECT/FIRE MARSHAL</b> Provides relative to fireworks
<b>HB 977</b>	<b>BEAULLIEU</b>	<b>COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS</b> Provides relative to minors' use of applications
