<b>HB 590</b>	<b>GLORIOSO</b>	<b>TRAFFIC/VIOLATIONS</b> Provides with respect to training law enforcement officers regarding certain traffic stops
<b>HB 647</b>	<b>BOURRIAQUE</b>	<b>PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS</b> Provides for application submission timelines for waterway projects
<b>HB 685</b>	<b>MENA</b>	<b>PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS</b> Provides with respect to the procurement of public motor vehicles and rolling stock
<b>HB 692</b>	<b>BROUSSARD</b>	<b>PUBLIC CONTRACTS</b> Provides relative to local government subdivisions entering into an agreement with group purchasing organizations
<b>HB 839</b>	<b>COATES</b>	<b>PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS</b> Provides with respect to a hospital service district use of "construction management at risk"
<b>HB 860</b>	<b>BRAUD</b>	<b>CONTRACTS/BIDS</b> Authorizes the use of fillable form to receive electronic public bids
<b>HB 873</b>	<b>GLORIOSO</b>	<b>MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC</b> Authorizes a supplemental fee to fund pursuit intervention technology
<b>HB 887</b>	<b>MCFARLAND</b>	<b>PUBLIC CONTRACT/BIDS</b> Provides for modifications to the Construction Management at Risk option in Public Bid Law
<b>HB 965</b>	<b>MCPMAHEN</b>	<b>HIGHWAYS</b> Designates a portion of Louisiana Highway 163 as the "Sergeant William 'Billy' Earl Collins, Jr., Memorial Highway"
<b>HB 972</b>	<b>BOUDREAUX</b>	<b>HIGHWAYS</b> Designates a portion of Louisiana Highway 93 in Lafayette Parish as the "Desert Shield-Desert Storm Memorial Highway"
<b>HB 982</b>	<b>THOMPSON</b>	<b>HIGHWAYS</b> Designates certain portions of highways in the state

**HB 1072      BOURRIAQUE**

**TRANSPORTATION DEPT** Reforms certain powers, duties, and responsibilities in the office of Louisiana Highway Construction

Any interested person or any committee member may file with the committee a prepared statement concerning a specific instrument or matter under consideration by the committee or concerning any matter within the committee's scope of authority, and the committee records shall reflect receipt of such statement and the date and time thereof.
