INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

<b>HCR 7</b>	<b>LANDRY, MANDIE</b>	<b>JUVENILES</b> Requests the Louisiana Department of Justice to issue a report on juveniles who are subject to electronic monitoring conditions
<b>HB 63</b>	<b>HORTON</b>	<b>BAIL</b> Provides relative to the placement of a defendant's name into the National Crime Information Center registry
<b>HB 70</b>	<b>WALTERS</b>	<b>CRIME/THEFT</b> Provides relative to contractor fraud
<b>HB 76</b>	<b>LANDRY, MANDIE</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS</b> Provides relative to notification of inmates released from a parish prison or jail
<b>HB 84</b>	<b>KNOX</b>	<b>CRIME/FELONIES</b> Designates felony hit-and-run driving as a crime of violence
<b>HB 132</b>	<b>GLORIOSO</b>	<b>CRIME/BATTERY</b> Provides relative to battery of a police officer
<b>HB 144</b>	<b>GLORIOSO</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of obstruction of a legislative proceeding
<b>HB 167</b>	<b>FREIBERG</b>	<b>PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECTIONS</b> Provides for the issuance of certain documentation and certification to inmates before their release from incarceration
<b>HB 275</b>	<b>BOYD</b>	<b>CHILDREN/ABUSE</b> Provides relative to the minimum sentencing for child domestic abuse convictions
<b>HB 298</b>	<b>LANDRY, MANDIE</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides relative to conduct that constitutes third degree rape
<b>HB 322</b>	<b>MELERINE</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Prohibits the assessment of any fees or costs against certain individuals who request a copy of testimony presented in executive session before the Board of Pardons and committee on parole
<b>HB 635</b>	<b>HORTON</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to criminal activity committed by an agent of a foreign adversary or an agent of a foreign terrorist organization
<b>HB 808</b>	<b>MCMAHEN</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides relative to the intentional exposure to HIV

<b>HB 883</b>	<b>SCHLEGEL</b>	<b>GAMBLING</b> Provides relative to enforcement of illegal online gambling
<b>HB 1054</b>	<b>VILLIO</b>	<b>EVIDENCE</b> Provides relative to self-authentication of certain evidence

Any interested person or any committee member may file with the committee a prepared statement concerning a specific instrument or matter under consideration by the committee or concerning any matter within the committee's scope of authority, and the committee records shall reflect receipt of such statement and the date and time thereof.
