INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

HB 414	CHENEVERT	HEALTH Provides for prohibitions on hiring individuals with certain criminal convictions
HB 457	KNOX	HOMELESS Establishes minimum housing standards for individuals experiencing homelessness
HB 475	BERAULT	HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS Requires a healthcare provider to obtain a patient's consent prior to recording a medical visit
HB 611	FREEMAN	HEALTH/WOMEN'S Provides relative to pregnancy-related service centers
HB 616	KNOX	MENTAL HEALTH Provides for oversight of publicly funded homeless service providers
HB 740	CHENEVERT	MEDICAID MANAGED CARE Provides for independent claims review of Coordinated System of Care providers
HB 897	LANDRY, MANDIE	HEALTH Provides relative to protecting healthcare data
HB 925	HENRY, CHANCE	SPEECH/PATH/AUDIO Provides relative to the practice of audiology and speech-language pathology
HB 926	BAYHAM	VACCINES/VACCINATION Prohibits the use of vaccine status to determine admission to public buildings
HB 931	LANDRY, MANDIE	HEALTH Prohibits a contractor or subcontractor of the Louisiana Pregnancy and Baby Care initiative from conditioning services on religious requirements
HB 949	COATES	HEALTH CARE/PROVIDERS Provides relative to the Louisiana State Radiologic Technology Board of Examiners
HB 1041	GALLE	HEALTH/MEDICAL TREATMENT Prohibits certain entities from prohibiting access based on a person's medical intervention status
HB 1076	MUSCARELLO	HEALTH/BEHAVIORAL Repeals the termination of the Louisiana Behavior Analyst Board

Any interested person or any committee member may file with the committee a prepared statement concerning a specific instrument or matter under consideration by the committee or concerning any matter within the committee's scope of authority, and the committee records shall reflect receipt of such statement and the date and time thereof.
