INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

<b>HB 21</b>	<b>GLORIOSO</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/MUNICIPAL EMP</b> Provides relative to participation in the Municipal Employees' Retirement System
<b>HB 24</b>	<b>OWEN, CHARLES</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/TEACHERS</b> Provides relative to the reemployment of retirees through a contract within the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana
<b>HB 26</b>	<b>FREEMAN</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/MUNICIPAL POL</b> Provides relative to partial dissolution of an employer in the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System
<b>HB 30</b>	<b>BACALA</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/MUNICIPAL POL</b> Provides relative to annual retirement education for certain participating employers in the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System
<b>HB 31</b>	<b>ECHOLS</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/MUNICIPAL POL</b> Authorizes certain municipalities to terminate participation in the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System
<b>HB 43</b>	<b>BAGLEY</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/STATE EMPS</b> Provides relative to retirement eligibility in the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System
<b>HB 45</b>	<b>BACALA</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/MUNICIPAL POL</b> Provides relative to benefits of participating employees in the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System
<b>HB 49</b>	<b>BACALA</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/STATEWIDE SYS</b> Provides relative to the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System and the Firefighters' Retirement System
<b>HB 993</b>	<b>FREEMAN</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/MUNICIPAL POL</b> Provides relative to earnable compensation for employees in the Municipal Police Employees' Retirement System
<b>HB 1017</b>	<b>KERNER</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/FIREFIGHTERS</b> Prohibits certain post-divorce earnable compensation in the Firefighters' Retirement System from being included in a former spouse's portion of community property
<b>HB 1134</b>	<b>BRAUD</b>	<b>RETIREMENT/STATE EMPS</b> Creates the Back-Deferred Retirement Option Program within the Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System

Any interested person or any committee member may file with the committee a prepared statement concerning a specific instrument or matter under consideration by the committee or concerning any matter within the committee's scope of authority, and the committee records shall reflect receipt of such statement and the date and time thereof.
