<b>HB 394</b>	<b>CHENEVERT</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Provides relative to conditional parole
<b>HB 396</b>	<b>MCKIN</b>	<b>EVIDENCE</b> Provides relative to the admissibility of autopsy photographs in first or second degree murder trials
<b>HB 426</b>	<b>PHELPS</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to criminal blighting of property
<b>HB 439</b>	<b>ZERINGUE</b>	<b>PAROLE</b> Provides relative to parole ineligibility

<b>HB 523</b>	<b>BRYANT</b>	<b>PARDON/PAROLE</b> Provides relative to parole eligibility for certain individuals
<b>HB 676</b>	<b>SPELL, ANNIE</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of fraudulent patient referrals or "body brokering"
<b>HB 772</b>	<b>MARTINEZ</b>	<b>BAIL</b> Provides relative to notice for warrant of arrest
<b>HB 1025</b>	<b>AMEDEE</b>	<b>DOMESTIC ABUSE</b> Provides relative to a violation of a protective order
<b>HB 1038</b>	<b>BOYER</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Provides relative to the authority of a marshal to issue commissions to deputy marshals

<b>HB 74</b>	<b>ECHOLS</b>	<b>LAW ENFORCEMENT</b> Creates a "Spectrum Alert" system to assist in locating missing persons with autism spectrum disorder
<b>HB 159</b>	<b>JACKSON</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Creates a pretrial incarceration alternative pilot program in Caddo Parish
<b>HB 175</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>LOTTERY</b> Provides for a new lottery game to benefit veterans of armed services
<b>HB 255</b>	<b>BAYHAM</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PENALTIES</b> Provides relative to wearing masks in public
<b>HB 330</b>	<b>BAYHAM</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PENALTIES</b> Provides relative to the desecration of graves and religious institutions
<b>HB 364</b>	<b>HELPS</b>	<b>POLICE/LOCAL</b> Requires police departments to provide notice of illegal discharge of a firearm
<b>HB 458</b>	<b>KNOX</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS</b> Provides relative to inmates who participate in work release programs
<b>HB 525</b>	<b>CARPENTER</b>	<b>PUBLIC SFTY/DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for the online publication and maintenance of certain data used and compiled by the DPS&C
<b>HB 568</b>	<b>FIRMMENT</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Provides relative to penalty enhancements for violations of drug free school zones
<b>HB 656</b>	<b>BRYANT</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Creates a pilot program that provides certain DPS&C programming and services to inmates
<b>HB 1033</b>	<b>BACALA</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to the definition of "critical infrastructure"
<b>HB 1034</b>	<b>BACALA</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Authorizes the establishment of temporary protection zones
<b>HB 1070</b>	<b>BRAUD</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/JUSTICE</b> Provides relative to the Trial Court Case Management Information Fund
