<b>HB 293</b>	<b>BOYD</b>	<b>DISCRIMINATION</b> Provides relative to employment discrimination based on gender identity and sexual orientation
<b>HB 390</b>	<b>WALTERS</b>	<b>EMPLOYMENT</b> Provides for unpaid leave for employees who are domestic abuse survivors
<b>HB 456</b>	<b>CHENEVERT</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to claims for benefits under workers' compensation
<b>HB 460</b>	<b>LANDRY, MANDIE</b>	<b>EMPLOYMENT/DISCRIMINATION</b> Provides relative to employment discrimination against certain employees being treated with medical marijuana
<b>HB 561</b>	<b>HILFERTY</b>	<b>HEALTH/ANATOMICAL GIFTS</b> Provides relative to unpaid leave for living organ donations
<b>HB 819</b>	<b>CREWS</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to the medical treatment schedule under workers' compensation
<b>HB 1101</b>	<b>MELERINE</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to maximum medical improvement, income benefits, the misrepresentation of benefits or payments, and the rehabilitation of injured employees under workers' compensation
<b>HB 1023</b>	<b>MENA</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides with respect to the selection of vocation rehabilitation counselors
<b>HB 1047</b>	<b>MENA</b>	<b>WORKERS COMPENSATION</b> Provides relative to requests for authorizations for prescription medications
