HB 1051	PHELPS	PROPERTY/VACANT SUBSTAND Provides relative to the demolition of certain dilapidated property in the city of Shreveport
HB 1080	PHELPS	PROPERTY/VACANT SUBSTAND Provides relative to condemned commercial property in the city of Shreveport
HB 1087	ADAMS	CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS Authorizes the city of Zachary to use certain inmates to cut grass in certain cemeteries
HB 1111	KERNER	CIVIL SERVICE/FIRE & POL Provides relative to the reemployment of certain employees of the fire and police civil service

HB 1215	BAYHAM	CULTURE/REC/TOURDEPT Provides relative to the disposition of certain historical statues and monuments
SB 78	JENKINS	SPECIAL DISTRICTS Provides for the governing authority of the Shreveport Downtown Development District. (8/1/26)
SB 148	STINE	PLANNING/ZONING Provides for compensation to the members of the Lake Charles planning commission. (8/1/26)
