<b>HB 56</b>	<b>VILLIO</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides relative to the imposition of fines for driving while impaired
<b>HB 68</b>	<b>SCHLEGEL</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to conduct that constitutes disturbing the peace
<b>HB 92</b>	<b>SCHLEGEL</b>	<b>CRIME/SEX OFFENSES</b> Provides relative to certain sex offenses
<b>HB 119</b>	<b>FONTENOT</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to unlawful dissemination or sale of images of another created by artificial intelligence
<b>HB 140</b>	<b>COX</b>	<b>JUVENILE PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to the time limitations governing juvenile delinquency proceedings
<b>HB 147</b>	<b>VILLIO</b>	<b>CRIME/RACKETEERING</b> Provides for the definition of the crime of racketeering
<b>HB 160</b>	<b>KNOX</b>	<b>DOMESTIC ABUSE</b> Increases the penalties for certain domestic violence offenses that involve strangulation
<b>HB 171</b>	<b>SPELL, ANNIE</b>	<b>BAIL</b> Provides relative to personal sureties
<b>HB 289</b>	<b>EGAN</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Provides relative to the time period between conviction and sentence
<b>HB 351</b>	<b>FONTENOT</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS</b> Provides relative to the reentry preparation program
<b>HB 552</b>	<b>BRYANT</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides relative to driving while intoxicated
<b>HB 784</b>	<b>COX</b>	<b>SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY</b> Provides relative to sex offender registration and notification requirements
