<b>HB 64</b>	<b>MUSCARELLO</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE</b> Provides relative to the recall of arrest warrants
<b>HB 100</b>	<b>MCKIN</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of felony speeding
<b>HB 102</b>	<b>WILEY</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of second degree cruelty to elderly and persons with infirmities
<b>HB 106</b>	<b>COX</b>	<b>DRUGS</b> Prohibits the administration of nonprescription medication to children without parental consent
<b>HB 137</b>	<b>JOHNSON, MIKE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/SENTENCING</b> Changes sentencing guidelines for posting or calling in threats to schools
<b>HB 152</b>	<b>MACK</b>	<b>CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES</b> Adds certain substances to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law
<b>HB 155</b>	<b>MCKIN</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to unlawful use of an unmanned aircraft system
<b>HB 175</b>	<b>HEBERT</b>	<b>LOTTERY</b> Provides for a new lottery game to benefit veterans of armed services
<b>HB 186</b>	<b>MELERINE</b>	<b>CRIME/THEFT</b> Creates the crime of theft of funds from the Louisiana Giving All True Opportunity to Rise (LA GATOR) Scholarship Program
<b>HB 337</b>	<b>BEAULLIEU</b>	<b>GAMING</b> Provides relative to charitable bingo and the issuance of special licenses
<b>HB 957</b>	<b>CARRIER</b>	<b>CORRECTIONS/PRISONERS</b> Provides relative to the transfer of prisoners

<b>HB 58</b>	<b>VILLIO</b>	<b>BAIL</b> Restricts post-conviction bail for certain offenders
<b>HB 69</b>	<b>VILLIO</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides relative to ignition interlock device offenses
<b>HB 82</b>	<b>VILLIO</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides relative to penalties for DWI offenses
<b>HB 93</b>	<b>TURNER</b>	<b>CLERKS OF COURT</b> Provides relative to the jury commission in Lincoln Parish
<b>HB 167</b>	<b>FREIBERG</b>	<b>PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECTIONS</b> Provides for the issuance of certain documentation and certification to inmates before their release from incarceration
<b>HB 231</b>	<b>BOYER</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Creates the crime of intentional evasion of service of process for certain court orders
<b>HB 264</b>	<b>GLORIOSO</b>	<b>DWI</b> Provides relative to operating a vehicle while intoxicated
<b>HB 429</b>	<b>LANDRY, JACOB</b>	<b>CRIME/THEFT</b> Adds theft or unauthorized entry of a critical infrastructure as a predicate crime for terrorism
<b>HB 635</b>	<b>HORTON</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to criminal activity committed by an agent of a foreign adversary or an agent of a foreign terrorist organization
<b>HB 806</b>	<b>LAFLEUR</b>	<b>CRIME</b> Provides relative to hit-and-run driving offenses
<b>HB 884</b>	<b>SPELL, ANNIE</b>	<b>CRIMINAL/VICTIMS</b> Provides relative to survivors of sexually-oriented criminal offenses
