INSTRUMENTS TO BE HEARD:

<b>HR 118</b>	<b>WRIGHT</b>	<b>TAX/INCOME-CREDIT</b> Creates a legislative subcommittee to study the potential establishment of a state income tax credit for certain water utility customers
<b>HR 196</b>	<b>OWEN, CHARLES</b>	<b>INSURANCE/PROPERTY</b> Establishes a special study committee to assess the impact of fallen trees on residential properties and property values and to make recommendations
<b>HR 237</b>	<b>OWEN, CHARLES</b>	<b>CENSUS</b> Memorializes Congress to enact a provision in the National Defense Authorization Act directing the Department of Defense to provide accurate on-base population counts for the decennial census
<b>HB 442</b>	<b>MARCELLE</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Provides relative to election sections for judgeship of the family court for East Baton Rouge Parish
<b>HB 443</b>	<b>MARCELLE</b>	<b>COURTS</b> Provides relative to the election sections for judgeship of the second district of the First Circuit Court of Appeal
<b>SCR 29</b>	<b>KLEINPETER</b>	<b>WATER QUALITY</b> Creates a joint legislative committee to study and make recommendations relative to the water quality of the Atchafalaya Basin.
<b>SCR 31</b>	<b>STINE</b>	<b>CONGRESS</b> Memorializes Congress to amend the National Voter Registration Act.
<b>SCR 33</b>	<b>MYERS</b>	<b>EDUCATION DEPARTMENT</b> Creates the Work-Based Learning Coordination Task Force.
<b>SB 202</b>	<b>KLEINPETER</b>	<b>ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for the increase of parish board of election supervisor meetings in certain parishes for certain races. (8/1/26)
<b>SB 319</b>	<b>PRESSLY</b>	<b>ELECTIONS DEPARTMENT</b> Provides for instructions to elections commissioners. (7/1/27)
