III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Bill No. 417 by Representative Ritchie

Representative Ritchie presented House Bill No. 417, which increases the state tax on certain tobacco products and dedicates the monies.

Representative Ritchie offered a set of technical amendments. He also offered a motion to adopt the amendments, to which there was no objection. The amendments were adopted by a vote of 17 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Robideaux, Barras, Wesley Bishop, Broadwater, Burford, Danahay, Guillory, Hazel, Hoffmann, Johnson, Lambert, Ritchie, Stokes, Thompson, Whitney, Patrick Williams, and Willmott voted yea.

Representative Broadwater offered a set of amendments to allocate 2% of the taxes collected to the Southeastern University Nursing Program. He also offered a motion to adopt the amendments, to which Representative Robideaux objected. The secretary called the roll and the motion failed to pass by a vote of 4 yeas and 12 nays. Representatives Broadwater, Ritchie, Patrick Williams, and Willmott voted yea. Representatives Robideaux, Barras, Wesley Bishop, Burford, Guillory, Hazel, Hoffmann, Johnson, Lambert, Stokes, Thompson, and Whitney voted nay.

There was no further discussion on the bill.

Representative Ritchie offered a motion to voluntarily defer action on House Bill No. 417, to which there was no objection. Action House Bill No. 417 was voluntarily deferred by a vote of 18 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Robideaux, Barras, Barrow, Wesley Bishop, Broadwater, Burford, Danahay, Guillory, Hazel, Hoffmann, Johnson, Lambert, Ritchie, Stokes, Thompson, Whitney, Patrick Williams, and Willmott voted yea.
