On behalf of Senator Foil, Mr. Lenny Kopowski, Louisiana Manufactured Housing Association, no address provided, (504) 606-8635, presented Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 67, which requests that local governmental subdivisions consider manufactured home chassis elevation when setting requirements for freeboard purposes.
