III. DISCUSSION

<u>Discussion of the functions of the LDH Health Standards Section as they relate to Louisiana Medicaid, particularly with respect to licensure of and sanctions against nursing homes</u>

Review of R.S. 40:2009.25 relative to emergency preparedness plans for nursing homes and discussion of actions by LDH to implement and enforce this law

Chairman Edmonds provided background information regarding the seven Louisiana nursing homes that evacuated to a warehouse in Independence, Louisiana, due to Hurricane Ida. The seven nursing homes in question were River Palms Nursing and Rehab (Orleans Parish), South Lafourche Nursing and Rehab (Lafourche Parish), Maison Orleans Healthcare Center (Orleans Parish), Park Place Healthcare Nursing Home (Jefferson Parish), West Jefferson Health Care Center (Jefferson Parish), Maison DeVille Nursing Home (Terrebonne Parish), and Maison DeVille Nursing Home of Harvey (Jefferson Parish).

Steve Russo, Louisiana Department of Health (LDH), 628 North 4th Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70802, (225) 342-9509, stated that LDH revoked the licenses and terminated the Medicare provider agreements of the aforementioned nursing homes. Mr. Russo discussed the ongoing investigation into the evacuations of these facilities during Hurricane Ida as well as the ongoing appeals process. Mr. Russo answered questions from the committee about evacuation policies LDH has in place for nursing homes; he also noted he would not be free to answer all questions the committee may have because of a lawsuit that had been filed against LDH.
