III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

Mr. Mark Moses, Division of Administration, Office of Facility Planning and Control, P.O. Box 94095, Baton Rouge, LA 70804, (225) 342-9654, provided a handout entitled "The 2021 Capital Outlay Bill", Exhibit A, which is included in the committee records.

Representative Riser in the chair

House Bill No. 2 by Representative Bishop

Representative Bishop presented House Bill No. 2, which provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget.

Representative Bishop offered amendments which:

(1) Change General Obligation Bond funding as follows:

Priority 1	\$	22,866,142
Priority 2	\$	7,789,500
Priority 5	\$	(197,795,050)

Representative Bishop offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 17 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bishop, Beaulieu, Bourriaque, Bryant, Butler, DeVillier, Farnum, Hughes, LaCombe, Magee, McMahan, Mincey, Orgeron, Riser, White, Willard, and Wright voted yea.

Mr. Ed Carlson, CEO, Odyssey House of Louisiana, 11251 North Tonti Street, New Orleans, LA 70119, (504) 494-9628, spoke in support of House Bill No. 2 and provided a handout, Exhibit B, which is included in the committee records.

Representative Riser offered a motion for staff to make technical corrections to House Bill No. 2. Without objection, the motion passed by a vote of 17 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bishop, Beaulieu, Bourriaque, Bryant, Butler, DeVillier, Farnum, Hughes, LaCombe, Magee, McMahan, Mincey, Orgeron, Riser, White, Willard, and Wright voted yea.

Representative Bishop offered a motion to report House Bill No. 2 with amendments. Without objection, House Bill No. 2 was reported with amendments by a vote of 16 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bishop, Beaulieu, Bourriaque, Bryant, Butler, DeVillier, Farnum, Hughes, LaCombe, McMahan, Mincey, Orgeron, Riser, White, Willard, and Wright voted yea.

House Bill No. 3 by Representative Bishop

Representative Bishop presented House Bill No. 3, which provides for the Omnibus Bond Act.

Representative Bishop offered amendments which: (1) add authorization for an issuance not to exceed \$400,000,000 in general obligation bonds for paying the first installment payment due by the state to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers which payment be made on or before Sept. 30, 2021; and (2) direct the treasurer to transfer \$400,000,000 upon receipt of the bond proceeds to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Representative Bishop offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 14 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bishop, Beaulieu, Bourriaque, Butler, DeVillier, Farnum, Hughes, LaCombe, McMahan, Mincey, Orgeron, White, Willard, and Wright voted yea.

Representative Bishop offered a motion to report House Bill No. 3 with amendments. Without objection, House Bill No. 3 was reported with amendments by a vote of 14 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bishop, Beaulieu, Bourriaque, Butler, DeVillier, Farnum, Hughes, LaCombe, McMahan, Mincey, Orgeron, White, Willard, and Wright voted yea.

For the purposes of this Paragraph, the term "source" shall mean a publication, website, person, or other source from which the data or statistical information contained in the prepared statement was obtained by the person or persons who prepared the statement.
