III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Bill No. 76 by Representative Huval

Representative Huval presented House Bill No. 76, which creates the "Electric Line Worker" specialty license plate.

Representative Marino offered a motion to report House Bill No. 76 favorably. Without objection, House Bill No. 76 was reported favorably by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Wright, Brass, Cormier, Firment, Freiberg, Gadberry, Horton, Marino, Moore, Charles Owen, Schamerhorn, and Selders voted yea.

House Bill No. 191 by Representative Charles Owen

Representative Charles Owen announced that House Bill No. 191 would be withdrawn and he would co-author House Bill No. 603 by Representative Gadberry.

House Bill No. 603 by Representative Gadberry

Representative Gadberry presented House Bill No. 603, which creates military honor specialty license plates.

Representative Gadberry offered amendments to:

- 1. Make technical changes.
- 2. Remove the handling fee of \$3.50 that was applicable to each military honor license plate.
- 3. Remove the inclusion of the U.S. flag background on each license plate.
- 4. Require the office of motor vehicles to create the military honor plates provided for

in proposed law when the applicable statutory provisions are met and its system is updated to accommodate new plates.

Representative Gadberry offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Wright, Brass, Cormier, Edmonston, Firment, Freiberg, Gadberry, Glover, Horton, Marino, Moore, Schamerhorn, and Selders voted yea.

Representative Schamerhorn offered a motion to report House Bill No. 603 with amendments. Without objection, House Bill No. 603 was reported with amendments by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Wright, Brass, Cormier, Edmonston, Firment, Freiberg, Gadberry, Glover, Horton, Marino, Moore, Schamerhorn, and Selders voted yea.
