### **III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION**

### House Resolution No. 181 by Representative Mincey

Representative Mincey presented House Resolution No. 181, which urges and requests the office of community development to work with the Louisiana Watershed Initiative to create an independent watershed region for the Amite River Basin.

Representative Charles Owen offered a motion to report House Resolution No. 181 favorably. Without objection, House Resolution No. 181 was reported favorably by a vote of 9 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Wright, Brass, Freiberg, Gadberry, Horton, Larvadain, Charles Owen, Pierre, and Schamerhorn voted yea.

#### Senate Bill No. 498 by Senator Stine

Senator Stine presented Senate Bill No. 498, which provides relative to DOTD and types of buildings processes.

Representative Wright offered amendments to:

- 1. Change proposed law from requiring the authority to accept unsolicited proposals for design build projects in excess of \$100,000.000.00 to authorizing the authority to accept unsolicited proposals for design build projects in excess of \$100,000.000.00.
- 2. Change the authorized number of days for interested bidders to submit an unsolicited proposal from no more than 60 days to no more than 120 days.
- 3. Require the review cost for all proposals for a design build project pursuant to proposed law be nonrefundable should the project not move forward.

Representative Wright offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Wright, Brass, Edmonston, Freiberg, Gadberry, Horton, Larvadain, Charles Owen, Pierre, and Schamerhorn voted yea.

Without objection, action on House Resolution No. 183 was voluntarily deferred by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Wright, Brass, Edmonston, Freiberg, Gadberry, Horton, Larvadain, Charles Owen, Pierre, and Schamerhorn voted yea.
