House Bill No. 2 by Representative Bacala

Representative Bacala and Senator Seabaugh presented House Bill No. 2, which provides for immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances for peace officers and public entities that employ or appoint peace officers.

Representative Glorioso offered an amendment to expand the definition of a peace officer. Representative Glorioso offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendment. Without objection, the amendment was adopted by a vote of 12 yeas, 0 nays, and 1 abstention. Representatives Brown, Carlson, Chenevert, Edmonston, Glorioso, Egan, Mike Johnson, Larvadain, Melerine, Taylor, Turner, and Wyble voted yea. Representative Muscarello abstained.
