III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

Senate Bill No. 181 by Senator Morris

Senator Morris presented Senate Bill No. 181, a constitutional amendment which provides for membership of the State Civil Service Commission.

At the request of the author, Representative Muscarello offered amendments to change the term limit for members of the State Civil Service Commission from three six-year terms to two four-year terms and provide that the governor shall assign staggered terms of up to four years for each member of the commission in office on January 1, 2025. Representative Muscarello offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Muscarello, Brown, Carlson, Chenevert, Edmonston, Egan, Glorioso, Larvadain, Melerine, Taylor, Turner, and Wyble voted yea.

Representative Muscarello offered amendments to change the election date from November 5, 2024, to December 7, 2024, and change the ballot language. Representative Muscarello offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Muscarello, Brown, Carlson, Chenevert, Edmonston, Egan, Glorioso, Larvadain, Melerine, Taylor, Turner, and Wyble voted yea.
