III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

House Bill No. 609 by Representative Firment

Representative Firment announced that action on House Bill No. 609, which provides for the appraisal process and employment of umpires, was voluntarily deferred.

House Bill No. 678 by Representative Firment

Representative Firment announced that action on House Bill No. 678, which provides relative to fair claims settlement practices, was voluntarily deferred.

House Bill No. 196 by Representative Bamburg

Representative Bamburg presented House Bill No. 196, which extends the insurance fraud investigation unit within the Department of Public Safety and Corrections.

Representative Firment offered amendments in the form of a substitute bill. Representative Firment offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representative Hebert offered amendments to retain the Examiners' Handbook found in present law and add the Market Regulation Handbook adopted by the National Assoc. of Insurance Commissioners. House Bill No. 511 by Representative Illg

Representative Illg presented House Bill No. 511, which provides relative to uninsured motorists and certain policy forms.

Representative Firment offered amendments originating in committee.

Ben Albright, Independent Insurance Agents and Brokers of Louisiana, 18153 E. Petroleum Dr., Baton Rouge, LA 70809, spoke in support of House Bill No. 511.

Representative Firment offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 16 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Firment, Bagley, Bamburg, Braud, Brown, Galle, Green, Hebert, Henry, Illg, Mike Johnson, Jordan, Mandie Landry, Mena, Phelps, and Wilder voted yea.

Hilary Segura, American Property Casualty Insurance Association, 8700 West Bryn Mawr Ave., Ste. 1200S, Chicago, IL 60631, spoke in opposition to House Bill No. 511.

Representative Jordan offered a motion to report House Bill No. 511 with amendments. Without objection, House Bill No. 511 was reported with amendments by a vote of 15 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Firment, Bagley, Bamburg, Braud, Brown, Galle, Green, Hebert, Henry, Illg, Jordan, Mandie Landry, Mena, Phelps, and Wilder voted yea.

House Bill No. 616 by Representative Green

Representative Green presented House Bill No. 616, which provides relative to actuarial reviews of healthcare legislation.

Representative Firment offered amendments to:

- (1) Add that a contractor may be a La.-based university department or academic faculty with experience analyzing health insurance premiums;
- (2) Require LDI to ensure that contractors are independent and free from conflicts of interest that might affect neutrality of actuarial reviews;
- (3) Delete language relative to limiting the number of reviews to 6 legislative proposals;
- (4) Require the estimate of the amounts necessary to defray the cost of the mandates for health insurance products to include an evaluation of whether the legislative proposal includes a mandate requiring defrayal of costs. Authorize LDI to seek this evaluation prior to requesting the remaining actuarial review required in proposed law;
- (5) Provide that proposed law does not delegate state or federal authority to a non-state entity, including authority to request fiscal impact analyses from the legislative fiscal office, or authority to make determinations regarding the legal status of state benefit mandates pursuant to state and federal law; and
- (6) Make technical changes.

Representative Firment offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 14 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Firment, Bagley, Bamburg, Braud, Brown, Galle, Green, Hebert, Henry, Illg, Jordan, Mandie Landry, Mena, and Wilder voted yea.

Representative Green offered a motion to report House Bill No. 616 with amendments. Without objection, House Bill No. 616 was reported with amendments by a vote of 14 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Firment, Bagley, Bamburg, Braud, Brown, Galle, Green, Hebert, Henry, Illg, Jordan, Mandie Landry, Mena, and Wilder voted yea.
