# Senate Bill No. 323 by Senator Talbot

Senator Talbot presented Senate Bill No. 323, which provides for fair claims processing.

Representative Firment offered amendments to make technical changes. Representative Firment offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Firment, Bagley, Bamburg, Braud, Galle, Glorioso, Hebert, Henry, Wilder, and Willard voted yea.

Representative Henry offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 323 with amendments. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 323 was reported with amendments by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. #### Senate Bill No. 370 by Senator Bass

Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Firment, Bagley, Bamburg, Braud, Galle, Glorioso, Hebert, Henry, Mena, Wilder, and Willard voted yea.

Jimmy Ordeneaux, Louisiana Farm Bureau Insurance Company, 701 Poydras St., Ste. 3800, New Orleans, LA 70139, spoke in support of Senate Bill No. 370.

Representative Henry offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 370 with amendments, to which Representative Willard objected. The administrative assistant called the roll, and Senate Bill No. 370 was reported with amendments by a vote of 10 yeas and 4 nays. Representative Mike Johnson offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 295 with amendments. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 295 was reported with amendments by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Firment, Bagley, Bamburg, Braud, Brown, Galle, Glorioso, Hebert, Henry, Mike Johnson, Mena, and Wilder voted yea.
