**III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION**

**Senate Bill No. 469 by Senator Price**

Senator Price presented Senate Bill No. 469, which provides for the Ascension Parish Road Infrastructure Development Districts.

Representative Stagni offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 469 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 469 was reported favorably by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Gadberry, Billings, Cox, Domangue, Farnum, Freiberg, Jackson, Knox, Lyons, Marcelle, Newell, Stagni, and Willard voted yea.

Representative Marcelle offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 14 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Gadberry, Bayham, Bilings, Cox, Domangue, Farnum, Freiberg, Jackson, Knox, Lyons, Marcelle, Newell, Stagni, and Willard voted yea.

Representative Newell offered a motion to report Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 39 with amendments. Without objection, Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 39 was reported with amendments by a vote of 13 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Gadberry, Bayham, Bilings, Cox, Domangue, Farnum, Freiberg, Jackson, Knox, Lyons, Marcelle, Newell, and Willard voted yea.

**Senate Bill No. 460 by Senator Duplessis**

Senator Duplessis presented Senate Bill No. 460, which provides for lead service line replacement.

Representative Lyons offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 460 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 460 was reported favorably by a vote of 12 yeas and 0 nays.
