III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

Motion to Limit Debate

House Resolution No. 272 by Representative Muscarello

Representative Muscarello presented House Resolution No. 272, which provides for a study of court reporter per-page transcription rates in Louisiana and a study of digital court reporting as an alternative to traditional reporting.

Representative Brown offered a motion to report House Resolution No. 272 favorably. Without objection, House Resolution No. 272 was reported favorably by a vote of 11 yeas and 0 nays. House Resolution No. 267 by Representative Firment

Representative Firment presented House Resolution No. 267, which memorialize congress to adequately fund law enforcement and emergency responders in parishes where the Kisatchie National Forest is located.
