III. DISCUSSION OF LEGISLATION

Senate Bill No. 1 by Senator Price

Senator Price presented Senate Bill No. 1, which allows for credit for out-of-state full-time law enforcement service.

Margaret Corley Michel, Louisiana State Police Retirement System, 9224 Jefferson Highway, Baton Rouge, LA 70809, spoke for information only on Senate Bill No. 1.

Representative Thomas offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 1 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 1 was reported favorably by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bacala, Berault, Carlson, Egan, Illg, Kerner, McMakin, Spell, Taylor, and Thomas voted yea.

Senate Bill No. 6 by Senator Abraham

On behalf of Senator Abraham, Senator Price presented Senate Bill No. 6, which establishes an exception to suspension of retirement benefits for court reporters who are reemployed by judicial districts or parishes where a critical shortage exists.

Representative Kerner offered a motion to report Senate Bill No. 6 favorably. Without objection, Senate Bill No. 6 was reported favorably by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bacala, Berault, Carlson, Egan, Illg, Kerner, McMakin, Spell, Taylor, and Thomas voted yea.

House Resolution No. 143 by Representative Bacala

Representative Bacala presented House Resolution No. 143, which creates a task force to study the feasibility of a phased retirement program for public postsecondary education systems.

Representative Bacala offered amendments to:

- (1) Add a requirement that the task force study the potential for providing an additional lifetime income.
- (2) Add the chief executive officer of the Office of Group Benefits to the task force.

Representative Bacala offered a motion to adopt the proposed amendments. Without objection, the amendments were adopted by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bacala, Berault, Carlson, Egan, Illg, Kerner, McMakin, Spell, Taylor, and Thomas voted yea.

Representative Thomas offered a motion to report House Resolution No. 143 with amendments. Without objection, House Resolution No. 143 was reported with amendments by a vote of 10 yeas and 0 nays. Representatives Bacala, Berault, Carlson, Egan, Illg, Kerner, McMakin, Spell, Taylor, and Thomas voted yea.
