**Introduction of House Bills
and Joint Resolutions**

The following named members introduced the following entitled House Bills and Joint Resolutions, which were read the first time by their titles and placed upon the calendar for their second reading and, under a suspension of the rules, were referred to committee as follows:

HOUSE BILL NO. 18—

BY REPRESENTATIVE WRIGHT

AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 51:3121(A)(7), (B)(1)(b)(v), and (C)(1), (2), and (3)(a) and to enact R.S. 51:3121(B)(1)(b)(vi) through (ix), relative to the competitive projects payroll incentive program; to provide relative to the program's eligibility requirements; to extend the duration of the program; to remove certain approvals; to provide relative to certain requirements for participation in the program; to provide for certain limitations; and to provide for related matters.

Read by title.

Under the rules, the above bill was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

HOUSE BILL NO. 19—

BY REPRESENTATIVE PRESSLY

AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 51:2453(2)(c)(i) and to enact R.S. 51:2453(2)(b)(ix), relative to the Quality Jobs Program; to authorize certain businesses to participate in the Quality Jobs Program; to provide for effectiveness; and to provide for related matters.

Read by title.

Under the rules, the above bill was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

HOUSE BILL NO. 20—

BY REPRESENTATIVES VILLIO AND BACALA

AN ACT

To enact Part XIV of Chapter 3 of Title 46 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be comprised of R.S. 46:460.101, relative to Medicaid-funded long-term services and supports; to provide for delivery of such services through a managed care program; to provide for duties of the Louisiana Department of Health in administering the Medicaid managed care program; to provide for submission of an application to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services by a certain date; to provide for minimum application criteria; to provide for a request for proposals process; to provide for sources of funding; to provide for audits;

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to establish deadlines for program implementation; to provide for rulemaking; and to provide for related matters.

Read by title.

House Bills and Joint Resolutions on Second Reading Reported by Committee

The following House Bills and Joint Resolutions on second reading reported by committee were taken up and acted upon as follows:

HOUSE BILL NO. 2—
BY REPRESENTATIVE BISHOP AND SENATOR ALLAIN
AN ACT

To provide with respect to the capital outlay budget and the capital outlay program for state government, state institutions, and other public entities; to provide for the designation of projects and improvements; to provide for the financing thereof making appropriations from certain sources; and to provide for related matters.

Read by title.

Reported with amendments by the Committee on Ways and Means.

The committee amendments were read as follows:

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Ways and Means to Original House Bill No. 2 by Representative Bishop

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 60, between lines 22 and 23, insert the following:

"Provided, however, that \$450,000 of the Priority 1 appropriation shall be used to fund the George W. Carver Playground Renovations

project, and \$200,000 of the Priority 1 appropriation shall be used to fund the Skateboard Park at the West Bank Park project."

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 91, between lines 15 and 16, insert the following:

"(16) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in this or any other Capital Outlay Act for the New Orleans West Bank Park Improvements, New Soccer and Recreational Facilities, and Skateboard Park project and the Norman Playground Basketball Gym, Planning and Construction project shall be deemed to include the George W. Carver Playground, Renovations and Upgrades project for the West Bank Park project and park enhancements for a walking track, basketball, football, and baseball fields and a concession stand for the Norman Playground project."

On motion of Rep. Bishop, the amendments were adopted.

On motion of Rep. Bishop, the bill, as amended, was ordered engrossed and passed to its third reading.

HOUSE BILL NO. 3—
BY REPRESENTATIVE BISHOP
AN ACT

To enact the Omnibus Bond Authorization Act of 2020, relative to the implementation of a five-year capital improvement program; to provide for the repeal of certain prior bond authorizations; to provide for new bond authorizations; to provide for authorization and sale of such bonds by the State Bond Commission; and to provide for related matters.

Read by title.

Reported favorably by the Committee on Ways and Means.

On motion of Rep. Bishop, the bill was ordered engrossed and passed to its third reading.
