FIRST LADY ALICE FOSTER WILL PARTICIPATE IN WOMEN'S CAUCUS SALUTE

The Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus and the Louisiana Women's Policy and Research Commission will salute "Take Our Daughters to Work Day," Thursday, April 25,.

The day will begin at 8:00 a.m. with a live interview at the Governor's Mansion with Women's Policy and Research Commission Chair Rep. Diane Winston by Vivian Glover of NBC's Today Show. At noon, First Lady Alice Foster will greet the group prior to the presentation of the 2002 Report of the Governor's Women's Policy and Research Commission.

Almost 500 people have R.S.V.P.'d for the luncheon, immediately following the program.
